Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding on academic, educational, and cultural cooperation (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") is signed, according to mutual interest and to respect the independence of both sides, on 24 November 2025 Solar Calendar equal to 24 November 2025 A.D. between the Islamic Azad University (IAU), represented Dr. Hamed Barjesteh address: No.223, North Iranshahr Street, Tehran, Iran, website: www.iau.ac.ir, email: info@iau.ac.ir (hereinafter referred to as the first party), and Prof. Dr. Idi Warsah, M.Pd, address Jl. Dr. AK Gani No.01, Curup, Dusun Curup, Kec. Curup Utara, Kabupaten Rejang Lebong, Bengkulu 39119, Indonesia, www.iaincurup.ac.id, email: kerjasamainternasional@iaincurup.ac.id represented by Institut Agama Islam Negeri (IAIN) Curup (Hereinafter referred to as the second party).

In case of any change in their respective addresses or emails, each party should inform the other party to the other party, in writing within 15 days; otherwise, all correspondence will be considered as to be forwarded.

The parties, wishing to establish a cooperative relationship through mutual assistance, agree to the following:

Article 1. Purposes & Scopes of Cooperation

- 1.1 Joint educational and research activities
- 1.2 Exchange of faculty members, researchers, and students
- 1.3 Sabbatical leaves
- 1.4 Joint Scientific seminars and conferences
- 1.5 Exchange of publications and academic texts
- 1.6 Holding joint courses and workshops
- 1.7 Joint collaboration in implementing professional (skillful) and common general short-term programs, in different Scientific, Technical, and Specialized fields.
- 1.8 Joint collaboration in the field of science & technology parks
- 1.9 Mutual Collaboration in the field of commercialization of knowledge
- 1.10 To study the feasibility of setting up the IAU's new branch in collaboration with a partner university
- 1.11 To disseminate both countries' languages and literature
- 1.12 To introduce both countries' art and civilization
- 1.13 To set up IAU's office in developed countries' universities

Article 2. Obligations

- 2.1 The two parties recognize that the implementation of any agreed-upon activities will depend on the interests and expertise of the individuals involved and the availability of financial resources, space, and other facilities.
- 2.2 The Parties understand that this MOU creates no financial and legal commitments for either party.
- 2.3 Before implementing any of the provisions of the MOU, it is necessary to regulate and sign a separate contract, which will be approved by the authorities of both universities.
- 2.4 Neither party may assign or otherwise transfer any of its rights or obligations under this MOU, in whole or in part, to a third party.
- 2.5 The parties undertake that any information obtained from the other party is considered confidential and is not accessible to the other directly or indirectly.
- 2.6 In case of mutual research or programs that lead to new technological knowledge, an outcome or invention, results are calculated with respect to the contribution of each of the parties. Partner's share will be calculated based on unique contracts signed by the two parties for performing the goals of this memorandum.

Article 3. Duration, Amendment, Extension, and Termination

- 3.1 This MOU will be valid from 24 November 2025 till 20 November 2030 Solar Calendar, equal to 24 November 2025 till 20 November 2030 AD, for five years.
- 3.2 The parties agree to review the activities undertaken and the progress made periodically and to consult concerning amendments, renewal, or termination of this MoU. The MoU can be modified upon mutual written consent.
- 3.3 Any revision or termination of this agreement shall not undermine the validity or implementation of separately concluded agreements.
- 3.4 The MOU may be extended upon the request of either party in writing three months before the termination of the initial period, and the termination of this agreement shall not affect the implementation of the current obligations of both parties.
- 3.5 This MOU, consisting of three articles, is prepared in Persian, English, and Indonesian, in three original copies, all copies being considered of identical legal validity. Any discrepancy/ies in the interpretation of this MoU shall be settled through negotiations between both parties' working groups. If negotiations fail to succeed, the matters will be referred to an impartial legal consultant or jury.
- 3.6 The two parties will form a mutual scientific and technological committee for the purpose of discussing the status and determining a cooperation program, pursuing, supervising, and evaluating the MoU objectives. (Results)
