



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) is entered into on this **7th day of August 2026** (“Effective Date”)

BETWEEN

1. **Institut Agama Islam Negeri (IAIN) Curup**, located at Jl. Dr. Ak. Gani No.01, Dusun Curup, Kec. Curup Utara, Kabupaten Rejang Lebong, Bengkulu 39119, Indonesia (Hereinafter Referred to as “IAIN Curup”);

AND

2. **FATIMA COLLEGE (AUTONOMUS)** located in Maryland, Vilangudi, Madurai, Tamilnadu, India - 524 320 (Hereinafter Referred to As “FC”).

Preamble

Recognizing the mutual benefits of collaboration, IAIN Curup and FC (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties") agree to establish a cooperative relationship to promote academic and research excellence in education field.

1. Shared Values

- 1.1 Academic excellence and integrity in teaching, research, and service.
- 1.2 Mutual respect for cultural diversity and international understanding.
- 1.3 Promotion of student success and lifelong learning opportunities.
- 1.4 Commitment to innovation, creativity and knowledge sharing.
- 1.5 Building sustainable partnerships that benefit both institutions and their communities.

2. Objectives

The objectives of this MOU are to:

- 2.1 Foster academic cooperation in teaching, training, and research in Education.
- 2.2 Facilitate the exchange of faculty, researchers, and students to enhance learning experiences.
- 2.3 Collaborate on joint research projects, publications, and academic conferences.
- 2.4 Develop and implement joint academic programs and workshops.
- 2.5 Promote the sharing of knowledge, resources, and best practices in Education Field
- 2.6 Promote cross-cultural understanding through educational and cultural activities.

3. Scope of Collaboration

The collaboration between the Parties may include, but is not limited to:



- 3.1 **Student Exchange Programs:** Short-term and long-term exchange opportunities for students.
- 3.2 **Faculty Exchange Programs:** Opportunities for faculty members to teach or conduct research at the partner institution.
- 3.3 **Joint Research Initiatives:** Collaborative research projects addressing contemporary issues in education.
- 3.4 **Workshops and Seminars:** Co-hosting educational events, seminars, and training sessions.
- 3.5 **Curriculum Development:** Sharing and co-developing innovative teaching methodologies, resources and course materials.

4. Implementation

- 4.1 The implementation of the collaborative activities shall be subject to the availability of resources and mutual agreement.
- 4.2 Each party shall designate a coordinator to oversee and facilitate the implementation of the activities outlined in this MOU.
- 4.3 Any specific activity under this MOU shall be governed by a separate agreement specifying the terms and conditions of the activity.
- 4.4. Activities will depend upon the availability of funds and resources at each institution.

5. Financial Arrangements

- 5.1 Each party shall bear its costs and expenses incurred in connection with this MOU unless otherwise agreed upon in writing.
- 5.2 Funding for joint projects shall be mutually agreed upon and arranged by the parties on a case-by-case basis.

6. Intellectual Property

- 6.1 Any intellectual property arising from joint activities shall be jointly owned by the parties unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- 6.2 Publications resulting from collaborative research shall duly acknowledge the contributions of both parties.

7. Duration and Review

- 7.1 This MOU shall remain in effect for a period of **five (5) years** from the date of signing unless terminated earlier by either party.
- 7.2 Either party may terminate this MOU by giving **three (3) months' written notice** to the other Party.
- 7.3 The termination of this MOU shall not affect ongoing activities initiated under its framework.



8. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising from the interpretation or implementation of this MOU shall be resolved amicably through mutual discussions.

9. General Provisions

9.1 This MOU is a statement of intent and does not create any legally binding obligations between the Parties.

9.2 Both Parties will conduct activities under this MoU in accordance with their respective laws, regulations and policies.

9.3 Any amendments to this MOU shall be made in writing and signed by both Parties.

9.4 This MoU will be reviewed periodically to assess progress and consider new areas of cooperation.

10. Signatories

This MOU is signed in two copies, with each Party retaining one original copy.
