



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN

THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TRI DHARMA OF HIGHER EDUCATION
CONCERNING EDUCATION, RESEARCH, HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT,
AND COMMUNITY SERVICE

On this day, Tuesday, December 4, 2024, the undersigned:

1. **Prof. Dr. Idi Warsah, M.Pd.I** : Rector of the State Islamic Institute of Curup, appointed based on the Decree of the Minister of Religious Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia Number 019558/B.II/3/2022 dated April 18, 2022, located at Jalan Dr. AK. Gani No. 1 Dusun Curup, Rejang Lebong Regency 39919, hereinafter referred to as the **FIRST PARTY**.
2. **Prof. Joseph Lee, PhD** : Vice Chancellor of INTI International University, located at Persiaran Perdana BBN Putra Nilai, 71800 Nilai, Negeri Sembilan, Malaysia, hereinafter referred to as the **SECOND PARTY**.

The parties agree to enter into a cooperation agreement in the field of Tri Dharma of Higher Education, which includes education, research, human resource development, and community service, governed by the provisions set forth below:

**ARTICLE 1
INTRODUCTION**

1. The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to synergize the potential and resources possessed by the parties to develop cooperation in the



implementation of Tri Dharma of Higher Education, including education, research, human resource development, community service, and the implementation of the Merdeka Campus program.

2. The objective of this cooperation is to optimize the utilization of resources and the potential quality possessed by each party in the implementation of their respective duties and functions, in accordance with their authority.

ARTICLE 2 **SCOPE OF COOPERATION**

The scope of this cooperation agreement includes:

- a. Organizing education, research, and training;
- b. Organizing community service activities;
- c. Improving and developing human resource competencies; and
- d. Other activities agreed upon by both parties.

ARTICLE 3 **IMPLEMENTATION OF ACTIVITIES**

1. The implementation of this cooperation agreement will be further detailed in one or more subsequent cooperation agreements, which will outline the specifics of each area of focus for the partnership program, in the form of a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) or other similar documents (if necessary).
2. The cooperation agreements referred to in paragraph (1) are considered an integral part of this Memorandum of Understanding.
3. The cooperation agreements referred to in paragraph (1) will delegate responsibilities to each unit based on the area of cooperation as outlined in Article 2.

ARTICLE 4 **FINANCING**

1. All costs arising from the implementation of this cooperation agreement will be borne by each party's respective budget, as well as other legitimate sources, in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.



ARTICLE 5
DISPUTE RESOLUTION

1. In the event of any dispute arising from the implementation of this cooperation agreement, it will be resolved amicably through mutual consultation. If an agreement cannot be reached, legal recourse will be pursued in accordance with the relevant laws and higher education ethics.

ARTICLE 6
OTHER MATTERS (DURATION, CONFIDENTIALITY, CORRESPONDENCE, OTHER PROVISIONS)

A. DURATION

1. This cooperation agreement is valid for a period of 5 (five) years, starting from the date it is signed by both parties.
2. This cooperation agreement may be extended no later than 3 (three) months before the expiration of the agreement.
3. If one of the parties intends to terminate this cooperation agreement, the concerned party must notify the other party in writing at least 3 (three) months prior to the expiration of the agreement.
4. This Memorandum of Understanding may terminate or become void under the following circumstances:
 - a. If future legislation specifically regulates matters that conflict with the scope of this cooperation agreement;
 - b. If the objectives of the parties, as outlined in Article 1, are not achieved; or
 - c. If there is a breach of confidentiality as described in Article 6, preventing either party from continuing the cooperation.
5. Should this cooperation agreement expire without renewal or termination, any agreements made relating to its implementation shall remain in effect until all rights and obligations of the parties are fulfilled, as stipulated in the cooperation agreements referred to in Article 3.

B. CONFIDENTIALITY

1. Both parties agree to exchange data and information related to the purpose and objectives of this cooperation agreement, to be used solely for the implementation of the agreement.



2. Unless required by applicable laws, both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of all data and information shared as per paragraph (1) and shall not disclose it to any third party without prior written consent from the other party.

C. CORRESPONDENCE

1. All correspondence and notifications required for the implementation of this cooperation agreement must be sent to the parties at the following addresses:

2. If any changes occur in the addresses during the implementation of this agreement, the party whose address has changed must notify the other party in writing no later than 7 (seven) days after the change.

D. OTHER PROVISIONS

1. This cooperation agreement is not legally binding on the parties.
2. The parties may create one or more legally binding cooperation agreements.
3. This cooperation agreement may be executed by both parties in good faith, even though it is not legally binding.
4. This agreement may be amended or supplemented only with written consent from both parties.



5. The implementation of this cooperation agreement will be monitored and evaluated by both parties, either individually or jointly, at least once a year, as part of the assessment for future cooperation.

**ARTICLE 7
CLOSING**

This cooperation agreement is executed in 2 (two) original copies, each with sufficient legal documentation, and both copies are equally binding. Each party shall retain 1 (one) original copy.
